The Herman and Virginia Gundlach Scholarships are:

- **one-year** scholarships
- **intended** for students in their senior year currently attending a **Kenosha County public high school**: Bradford, Harborside Academy, Indian Trail, Lakeview Tech, Reuther, Tremper, Westosha Central and Wilmot.
- students must have a Grade Point Average (**GPA**) **between 2.5 to 3.5** (out of 4.0).
NOTE: Gundlach Scholarships are targeted to students with GPA's between 2.5 to 3.25.
- awarded to students who **plan to attend a four-year college, university or 2 year accredited technical school in the state of Wisconsin.**

Consideration shall be given for evidence of financial need as well as participation in school and community volunteer activities and work experience. Applications for Gundlach Scholarships must be returned by student applicants to the Kenosha Community Foundation office no later than **March 4, 2021**.
