

The Kenosha Community Foundation's Cropley Scholarship 2021 Application Form

The Kenosha Community Foundation invites Kenosha County residents currently attending college to apply for the Cropley Scholarships.

The scholarships, which honor the late Ward Cropley, the former head of classified advertising at the Kenosha News, and his wife Jesse Cropley, were established to: *provide financial assistance to "needy and worthy students, who are desirous of and ambitious to receive a college, university, or other higher education, and who without financial assistance, would be unable to acquire such college, university or higher education."*



To be eligible for the Foundation's Cropley Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a resident of Kenosha County.
- Be an undergraduate enrolled at an accredited college/university located in the state of Wisconsin and have completed at least one year of study.
- Have a minimum 3.0 grade point average (GPA) out of 4.0.

All academic majors can apply. Multiple scholarships will be awarded based on the number and strength of applications received. (In 2020, the Foundation awarded multiple Cropley Scholarships at \$3,000/scholarship.)

Applications will only be accepted via email.
