



The Howard J. Brown Scholarship Kenosha Community Foundation **2021 Application Form**

The Kenosha Community Foundation invites Kenosha County residents to apply for the Howard J. Brown Scholarship. To be eligible for the scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a resident of Kenosha County.
- Be an undergraduate who has completed at least one year of study at an accredited college/university located in the state of Wisconsin.
- Have a minimum 3.5 grade point average (GPA) out of 4.0.
- NOTE: All academic majors can apply.

In 2021, the Foundation expects to award two Howard J. Brown Scholarships at \$2,500/scholarship.

Established in 2019, the scholarships honor the late Howard J. Brown, former publisher of the Kenosha News and long-time member of the Kenosha Community Foundation Board of Directors. The one-year scholarships were established *“for the benefit of students that meet criteria with regard to need and scholastic or professional promise.”*
