The Clay Davison Legacy Fund, established in 2020, will award a one-year scholarship to a resident of Kenosha County who is:

- a high school senior and plan to attend a two-year or four-year college or university degree at an accredited Wisconsin institution, or
- a student currently enrolled at a Wisconsin-based college/university or accredited technical school.

Applicants must plan to study or continue their studies in a mental health-related field.

Students of any Grade Point Average (GPA) may apply.

Consideration shall be given for evidence of financial need as well as participation in school and community volunteer activities and work experience.

In 2022, the Foundation has \$3,400 to award in the Clay Davison Legacy Fund Scholarship.

Applications for the Clay Davison Legacy Fund Scholarship must be returned by student applicants to the Kenosha Community Foundation office no later than **March 7, 2022**.
