The Rizzo Family Memorial Scholarship Fund was established by the Rizzo children in 2020 in memory of their father – Dr. Vincent C. Rizzo, their mother – Mary C. Rizzo, and their uncle – Dr. Michael J. Rizzo. The fund will award a one-year scholarship to a resident of Kenosha County who is:

- a high school senior and plan to attend a two-year or four-year college or university degree at an accredited Wisconsin institution, or
- a student currently enrolled in a Wisconsin-based college/university or accredited technical school.

Applicants must plan to study or continue to study a health-related field of study and have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 (out of 4.0) or better.

Consideration shall be given for evidence of financial need as well as participation in school and community volunteer activities and work experience.

For 2022, the Foundation plans to award one Rizzo Family Memorial Scholarship of \$1,000.

Applications for the Rizzo Family Memorial Scholarships must be returned by student applicants to the Kenosha Community Foundation office no later than **March 7, 2022**.
