The Fellman Family Fund Scholarship, established in 2019, will award a one-year scholarship to an area student athlete (preferably a cross-country or track athlete) in their senior year who:

- Will graduate from a Kenosha County public high school – Bradford, Harborside Academy, Indian Trail Academy, Lakeview Tech, Reuther, Tremper, Westosha Central, or Wilmot.
- Possesses a cumulative 3.5 (out of 4.0) Grade Point Average
- Plans to attend the University of Wisconsin (UW) at Madison

Note that a preference will be given to a student that plans to study a Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM), Health Care or Business related-field.

Consideration will also be given for an applicant's participation in other school activities, community volunteer efforts and work experience.

In 2022, the Foundation plans to award one \$1,000 Fellman Family Fund Scholarship.

Applications for the Fellman Family Fund Scholarship must be returned by student applicants to the Kenosha Community Foundation office no later than **March 4, 2022**.
